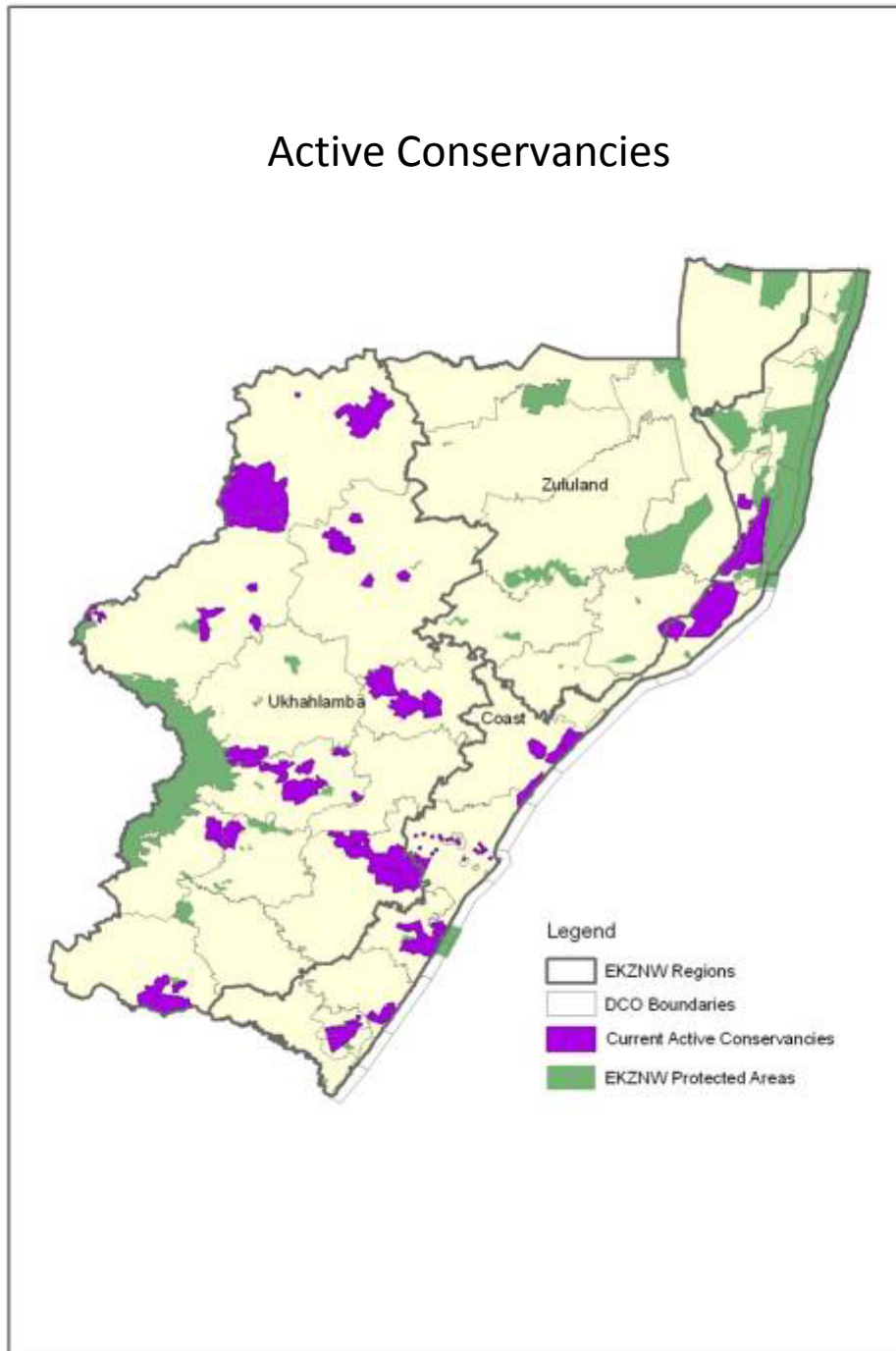

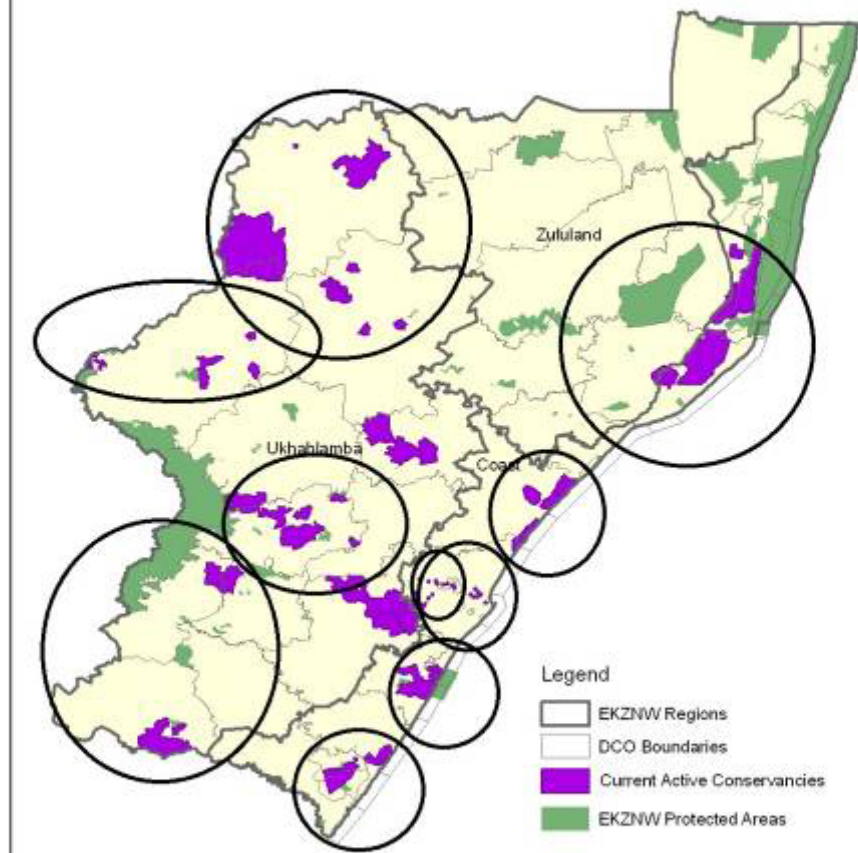


KZNCA Membership
